

Degree Evaluation What-If

SUNY Corning Community College students in the ACE program should claim their SUNY CCC student account by following the directions attached. They can get their CID and username (their SUNY CCC email) from any of their ACE Instructors as this information is in the Instructor's SUNY CCC [class list](#).¹

The electronic Degree Evaluation available to students through MyCorning shows how SUNY CCC courses completed and in progress (enrolled in but not completed) fit into [Liberal Arts and Sciences: Humanities and Social Sciences AS](#)² program requirements.

Navigation and Degree Evaluation Directions:

Upon login to MyCorning, this path leads to the Degree Evaluation: Student Resources > My Banner > Student Profile > Degree Evaluation (left side of Profile page).

In the Degree Evaluation, these directions will produce the evaluation for the degree listed above:

- Select "What-If"
- In the "Program" section,
 - select Catalog: the anticipated high school graduation year (or the newest catalog year available)
 - select Program: LAS: Huma/SocSci-AS (IndvStud)
- Then "Process" (scroll to bottom, on the right)

In the Degree Evaluation produced, scroll to the bottom of the page for the Legend, which defines each symbol, i.e., green circle with check mark = requirement complete.

ACE Course Availability:

SUNY CCC's ACE program course offerings are best predicted by high school/BOCES ACE Coordinators.

SUNY CCC's [High School College Education Online](#)³ (HS CEO) course options are generally scheduled for Fall Semester and Summer Terms by May 1 and Spring Semester by Dec. 15.
